LIVE OAK, FLA., Sept. 8, 2017 – The Suwannee River Water Management District (District) will close offices on Monday, September 11, 2017 in accordance with Governor Scott's directive. Additionally, the governing board meeting and public hearing planned for September 12, 2017 has been rescheduled to September 20, 2017 at District headquarters. The governing board meeting will begin at 3:00 p.m. and the public hearing to discuss millage and the District's tentative fiscal year (FY) 2018 budget will begin at 5:05 p.m.

The second September governing board meeting and public hearing planned for September 26, 2017 will remain scheduled. The governing board meeting will begin at 3:00 p.m. and the public hearing to approve the millage and the District's final FY 2018 budget will begin at 5:05 p.m. The meeting and hearing will be hosted at District headquarters.
